BANK LINKAGE PROGRAM:

Our Self Help Group-Bank Linkage Programme (SHGBLP) aims to deliver financial products & services to the section of the people of the state that lacks access to formal banking. This segment,often from the lower income, meets its financial needs through informal sources such as money lenders, traders, family and friends etc. However, these sources have their own limitations. Under this programme, individuals are organized in groups known as Self Help Groups (SHGs) by Rural Development Society.

The SHGs are also encouraged to take up livelihood activities, for which skill training is provided by the NGO. The members of the SHG are encouraged to promotes themselves for self Employment. They were also provided with knowledge on managing books of accounts. SHGs get inked to banks via Rural Development Society, for opening savings account and for their credit requirements. Banks lend to SHGs after assessing their credit worthiness on parameters such as group discipline, regularity of meetings, savings, rotation offunds, maintenance of books of accounts, group record keeping Repayment of loans etc. Access to finance by the poor and Vulnerable groups is a prerequisite for poverty reduction and Social cohesion. This has to become an integral part of our efforts to promote inclusive growth. In fact, providing access to finance is a form of empowerment of the vulnerable groups. Financial inclusion denotes delivery of financial services at an affordable Cost to the vast sections of the disadvantaged and low income groups. Through graduated credit, the attempt must be to lift the poor from lower level to the higher one so that they can come out of poverty.

NABARD PIGGERY AND DAIRY PROGRAMME:

Pork is very popular and in high demand in the state. Pig farming is economically profitable provide the same is done in a scientific and proper manner. Through knowledge of all aspects is essentialfarming and imparting the required knowledge, the society has been conducting training camps on piggery under which participants from different villages attend the camps. They are taught about the selection of exotic variety, breeding, feeding, medicine etc.

The society has also been imparting know how and awareness on dairy farming which can provide good opportunities of income for the weaker sections of the society. Under this initiative, the Society gave knowledge on the means to acquire milk producing cattle and effective ways to maximize the dairy output without causing harm to the cattle. The society has also been providing with information on the local markets where the dairy farmers could sell their produce at the optimum rates to enable them to earn decent profits.

MUDRA BANKING LOAN AWARNESS PROGRAMME:

The society had conducted Mudra banking Loan Awareness Programme, under which the Common people with a zeal to start their own business were invited. These were the people who wanted to start up a new business but did not have the requisite finances to start with. The programme focused on explaining the people about what Mudra loan iS, who is it for, what are the various stages of the loan and the ways to avail the loan facility. There was a good response from the Society with people asking questions they had in mind to which solution and recommendations were provided as best they could have been. Various retired ex-bankers and respected dignitaries from the Society also graced this occasion with their presence and made it a grand one.

BANKING COMPLIANCE (KYC) SEMINAR:

A seminar was conducted by our society for educating the masses about the banking compliances and regulations. Banking facilities still being new to some strata of people in the city, they find it difficult to adhere to the everyday changing regulations brought in by the banking authorities. This seminar was aimed at informing the people on how to use the banking facilities and with the rules and regulations and avoid penalty charged by bank due to various reasons. People turned out in good numbers to attend the seminar.

FORMATION &TRAINING OF SELF HELP GROUP/ COOPERATIVE SOCIETY:

The Society has given importance for the income generation of the rural and poor people of the society. The society has been trying for the betterment and uplift of the poor and needy sinceinception. It has been trying it effort to build the concept of shelf help group among villagers and gaining fruitful result. It has helped in the formation of many SHGS and Co-operative societies in the district of East Kameng of Arunachal Pradesh. These SHGs and Co-Operative societies are mainly engaged in Handlooms, Cutting and Knitting, Agriculture, Poultry, Piggery and Guttery. Capacity building and skill development of the society. To promote financial inclusion, microfinance is also encouraged among the SHGs and co-operative societies.

HOUSE HOLD SURVEY PROGRAM:

The Current Population Survey (Household Survey) is a monthly survey of households conducted by our Society. The household survey includes people on unpaid leave among the employed. The establishment survey does not. The household survey is limited to workers 16 years of age and older. 'Household Survey' is the process of collecting and analyzing data to help us understand the general situation and specific characteristics of individual house holder of all households in the population. Tools used for collecting data include a series of questions, observation checklists and records of discussions.

HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM:

The six major government health care programs—Medicare, Medicaid, the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP), the Department of Defense TRICARE and TRICARE for Life programs (DOD TRICARE), the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) program, and the Indian Health Service -(IHS) program—provide health care
